After 20 minutes, everyone will switch partners and spend some time chatting and working with a new person. At the end of the day, we will all share a Farm to Table supper and social.

Come just to get out of the city if you like! Bring a few friends with you! We have a great Crew House where you can sleep and cook or bring your tent or RV to the yard.
